

Frida Class Supply List

Body

- 1/3 yard bleached muslin cotton
- 5-6 tea bags to dye muslin
- 1 small skein fine black yarn or 36" long x 8 ½" (spread out to a thin layer) mohair – silk tussah or roving
- Sewing thread in dark brown and black
- Tacky glue
- Strip of tissue paper 1 ½" x 9"
- Bag of stuffing.
- 18" of 18 gauge wire for armature in hands
- Optional: Pink floss for X markings for surgeries.
- Two 8mm wood balls with two toothpicks

Corset

- 10" x 12" piece of gauze-like cotton fabric or old tea towel, thinner linen. + Corset paper Applique will be included in Undergarment Lesson Plan. + 2 yards of ¼" ribbon

Panties

- 10" x 12" piece of cotton fabric + optional lace ½" (+/-) x 12". + 12" of ¼" white ribbon.
- (White) Underskirt with waistband: 18" x 36" or ½ yard lightweight cotton-can be embroidered, eyelet + optional holán additional border ruffle 4" x 36"
- 1 yard of ¼" – ½" (white) ribbon for ties
- Modpoge or Fabric Stiffener + 1" sponge brush
- Optional: Twenty 1/8" eyelets + eyelet setter

Huipil Top

- Two pieces of 6" x 12" cotton fabric- one for top fabric and one for liner
- Overlay ribbon 1" x 19" or create your own with fabric: 2 ¼" x 19"
- Optional: Neck trim ½" x 13 ½" ribbon or create your own with 1 ¾" x 13 ½" fabric

Overskirt with waistband

- 15" x 36" cotton or satin fabric (special note: velvet will probably be too thick.) + printed cotton hemline 2" x 36"
- 36" of varied trims and/or fabric around skirt to add up to 4" when stacked
- 1 yard of ¼" – ½" satin ribbon for ties

Mariposa Headdress

- 2 yards of ½" or 8mm (silk) ribbon. Silk for flowers or buy your own premade.
- Butterfly: 5" x 4" piece of framing mat board. 1 Skein Perle cotton + 1 black pipe cleaner
- Tacky Glue
- Earrings
- Choice of beads and gold thread. Optional: Beads for necklace.

Materials for coloring

- Craft Acrylic paint: Medium Grey, Dark Salmon, Apple Spice, Raw Umber, White, Pearl white metallic, Cobalt Blue
- Chalks for Face: Pink, Terra Cotta, Grey, Periwinkle
- Optional for Butterfly : PearlEx powdered pigments #687 True Blue, #685 Spring Green, #690 Sparkle Copper, #658 Aztec Gold. You can also use metallic paint or a light dusting of glitter.
- Colored Pencils for detailing: Brown- medium tone, Dark purple, Charcoal
- Black Fine Line Marker
